

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF DAY CAMPERS

### DROP OFF AND PICK UP FOR DAY CAMPERS:

Day camp hours are Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Please advise us if you are going to be late. All campers must check in and check out with their counsellor. Cars should park on the south side of the 13<sup>th</sup> line and parents should accompany their campers beyond the camp gate to check in or out with their camper's counsellor. No dogs are allowed in camp.

### DIRECTIONS TO CAMP:

**From the south:** take Simcoe Road 88 to the lights at the 10<sup>th</sup> Side Road (WalMart/PetroCan Station). Travel north 8 km to the 13th line. Turn left (west). Continue approximately 250 metres to #3155 on the left side.

**From the north:** Take Hwy. 89 to the 10<sup>th</sup> Side Road (east of Cookstown Outlet Mall). Travel south on the 10<sup>th</sup> SR to the 13th line. Turn right (west) and continue approximately 250 metres to #3155 on the left side. Camp staff will be available. Camp telephone (905) 775-2694

**For Google, Map Quest or NAV Systems: You must input the co-ordinates - 44.1785 N, 79.6236 W.**

**IMPORTANT NOTE: If you input "Hollows Camp" or our address into Google, MapQuest, Blackberry or NAV System you will be sent somewhere that you do not want to go.**

### OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL COSTS:

**For Riders:** Riding helmets and safety vests may be rented at: \$10.00 per week for a helmet and \$15.00 per week for a vest. Please note that insurance regulations require that all riders wear approved head gear. Bike or hockey helmets are not acceptable.

**For Paintball:** Paintballs are sold at 100 balls for \$10.00. For reasons of safety and quality control all paintballs must be purchased from our inventory. Campers may not bring paintballs into camp.

### LUNCH:

Campers should bring their own lunch from home each day. Lunches should be clearly labelled with the camper's name as they will be kept in the kitchen under refrigeration and distributed during the lunch period. **Please note: The Hollows Camp is a peanut free environment.**

### CELL PHONES:

All camper cell phones will be kept in central locked storage while camp is in session. They will be available for use each day right after lunch period only if needed. Please provide a zip lock bag with camper's name on it for their cell phone.

### CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Campers will not subject other campers or camp staff to verbal or physical bullying.
- Campers are to respect the property and privacy of others.
- Theft, vandalism, smoking, alcohol or illicit drug use are unacceptable.
- Consequences can include being sent home from camp.
